ACTION REQUESTED:

Consider approval of extension of Interlocal Agreement for participation in Fort Worth's Environmental Collection Center, Household Hazardous Waste Program, from October 1, 2008, through September 30, 2009.

ALTERNATIVES:

- Pass: Continue existing contract with the City of Fort Worth Environmental Collection Center.
- Deny: Cancel hazardous household material collection service for current Euless residents.
- Table: Current contract with City of Fort Worth Environmental Collection Center will expire September 30, 2008.

SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The City of Euless has successfully participated in Fort Worth's Environmental Collection Center program since 1997. This service agreement provides for year-round access for current Euless residents to the Environmental Collection Center at 6400 Bridge Street, Fort Worth, and City access to the Crud Cruiser mobile unit during the year as scheduling permits. The rate for the next year will remain unchanged at \$47.00 per participating household.
