This office has concluded its review of the referenced plan, in conformance with Interim Final Rule on Mitigation Planning (44 CFR Part 201.6). This plan identifies six jurisdictions included within the plan (see attached list).

This letter serves as a notification that the Tarrant County Mid-Cities Plan has met all necessary revisions to achieve approvable pending adoption. The following condition must still be met in accordance to the letter dated September 30, 2008:

1. Formal approval of this plan is contingent upon the adoption of this plan by the participants as well as the receipt of all components of this plan in an electronic form (CD). Adoption resolutions must be submitted to this agency for review and approval no later than 120 days from the date of this letter. Failure to submit these resolutions in a timely manner could lead to a required update of the plan prior to FEMA approval.

As agreed in FEMA's letter dated September 30, 2008, it is not necessary that the Tarrant County Mid-Cities Plan meet the new October 1, 2008, planning regulations once all other requirements were met. A letter of official approval will be generated from this office upon presentation of jurisdictional adoption resolutions prior to January 28, 2009. Please advise the referenced jurisdictions of these requirements.
