Motion to approve an Interlocal Agreement Between the City of Euless and Tarrant County, Texas, regarding the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) and participation of the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program Award.

SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The Recovery Act (ARRA) of 2009 will provide stimulus funding through the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program Award. These particular funds are part of an allocation process, based on a formula created at the federal level. The City of Euless portion of these allocated federal funds is \$61,820. This particular grant has to be submitted as a multi-agency process through counties. Tarrant County will administer this grant application process, including the required reporting process. The fee for this grant administration, based on an existing formula in place with Tarrant County, is sixteen (16%) percent, or \$9,891. The remaining \$51,929 of Euless funding will be utilized for police department equipment.
