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### **ACTION REQUESTED:**

Authorize the Mayor to execute Agreements with the City of Fort Worth for a Reclaimed Water Line Easement, a Reclaimed Water Line Temporary Construction Easement, and a Temporary Right of Entry Agreement.

### **SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:**

On May 26, the City Council authorized the City Manager to execute an agreement with the City of Fort Worth for the purchase of reclaimed water.

In order to commence the process of construction for the Village Creek reclaimed water project, the City of Euless is requested to execute agreements with the City of Fort Worth for the placement of a permanent reclaimed water line easement and preceding rights of entry and construction easement to the City of Fort Worth allowing for the construction of the reclaimed water line. The property under consideration is located north of Moiser Valley Road and the Railroad Right-of-Way on property owned by the City of Euless.

Staff recommends the Council authorize the Mayor to execute the agreements in order to place the easements and allow right-of-entry to the property.
