SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The Alarm Ordinance will regulate the permitting of each residential and business alarm in the city, set forth the fee and fine schedule for the use of alarms, set a yearly renewal fee for each alarm and provide the Police Department with updated information on each alarm permit holder.
