

PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION

Establishment:	The Planning and Zoning Commission was established by ordinance on March 19, 1955.
Purpose:	To protect every interest of the people of Euless related to the physical changes of the City.
Duties:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">(1) Make and recommend a master plan;(2) Prepare a comprehensive plan for zoning the City;(3) Perform such other duties as may be prescribed by ordinances of the City and laws of the State. <p style="text-align: center;">Capital Improvement Advisory Committee</p>
Powers:	To make rules, regulations, and bylaws for itself subject to City Council approval.
Members:	Seven, who are Euless residents.
Term:	Two years; three members selected in odd numbered years and four members selected in even numbered years.
Meetings:	Minimum once a month; presently meets on the first and third Tuesday of each month, at 6:30 P.M., in the Council Chambers of the Euless City Hall.
Officers:	Planning and Zoning Commission elects their own Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and Secretary.
Quorum:	A majority (4).
Other:	The Planning and Zoning Commission also serves as the City of Euless Capital Improvements Advisory Committee.
