

PETITION TO THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EULESS, TEXAS

Name of subdivision:

The undersigned, being an officer authorized to act on behalf of the governing body of the above referenced entity that maintains the roads in the above referenced subdivision, hereby petitions the City Council of the City of Euless, Texas, under the provisions of Section 542.008 of the Texas Transportation Code, to extend by ordinance all traffic rules that apply to a road owned by the said City of Euless to the roads in said subdivision, so that the roads of said subdivision are under the same traffic rules as applied to all public streets within the City of Euless. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the above referenced entity specifically petitions for the following specified traffic rules to be extended by ordinance to the roads within the above named subdivision:

Traffic rules and regulations relating to the following subjects under the following provisions of the Texas Transportation Code:

- (1) Failure to yield to an emergency vehicle--Section 545.156.
- (2) Interfering with emergency vehicles--Section 545.407.
- (3) Crossing a fire hose--Section 545.408.
- (4) Regulations governing parking, stopping or standing--Sections 545.302 and 545.303.
- (5) Removal of unlawfully stopped vehicle--Section 545.305.
- (6) Passing a school bus--Section 545.066.

- (7) Driving with expired, wrong or fictitious license plates or registration insignia-- Sections 502.407 and 502.409.
- (8) Driving without a driver's license, or with an expired, suspended or revoked license-- Sections 521.021, 521.451, 521.457.
- (9) Failure to maintain financial responsibility (no insurance)--Sections 601.191, 601.195.
- (10) Failure to comply with a lawful order of a police officer--Section 542.501.
- (11) Maximum speed requirement--Section 545.351.

It is expressly understood in making this petition that the City Council of the City of Euless may require that owners of property in the above named subdivision shall pay all or part of the cost of extending and enforcing the above referenced traffic rules in the subdivision, including the costs associated with the placement of necessary official traffic control devices.

It is further expressly understood in presenting this petition that the Euless City Council may direct placement of official traffic control devices on property abutting the private roads in this subdivision when those devices relate to one of the traffic rules specified above. To the extent of all property owned by the above named entity which maintains the roads in the above named subdivision on the date of the presentation of this petition, such entity hereby gives consent, as the owner of said property, for the placement of all necessary or useful traffic control devices to regulate traffic and the conduct of vehicles on said roads.


