**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Amending Chapter 82, "Traffic and Motor Vehicles", Article III, "Operation of Vehicle", Section 82-67, "Same – Streets designated; Emergencies; Truck traffic confined; Emergency Vehicles excepted" to provide for the designation of truck routes.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

**SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:**

Ordinance No. 1903 governs the movement of commercial truck traffic throughout the city. It is necessary to update this ordinance to facilitate the orderly and safe movement of commercial truck traffic through the city and to specify the exclusive routes that must be used by these trucks. Since the last time this ordinance was updated several streets have been designed to accommodate commercial truck traffic, and the updating of this ordinance will allow for a more efficient distribution of truck traffic throughout the city.
