Consider approval of Order cancelling the May 14, 2011, general city officer election and declaring unopposed candidates for the Offices of Mayor, City Council Place 2 and City Council Place 4 be elected to the office in accordance with provisions of Subchapter C of Chapter 2, Texas Election Code.

SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

Incumbent Mary Lib Saleh, Mayor, Incumbent Leon Hogg, Place 2, and Incumbent Donna Mickan, Place 4, each filed an application for a place on the May 14, 2011, election ballot. The deadline for filing an application for a place on the ballot was 5 p.m., Monday, March 14, and no other candidates filed applications. The deadline for a write-in candidate to file was 5:00 p.m., Monday, March 21, and no write-in applications were received. Certification of the Unopposed Status was delivered to the City Council Members on March 22, 2011, as required by Section 2.052 of the Election Code. Therefore, in accordance with Section 2.053 of the Texas Election Code, the City Council may declare each unopposed candidate elected to office. This Order of Cancellation thereby cancels the election.
