SUBJECT: Consider Resolution No. 11-1366 renaming Harrington Gardens Parkway to Rio Grande Boulevard

SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The subdivision plat for Heritage Towne Crossing addition created a north-south right-of-way extending south from Glade Road. A four (4) lane divided roadway was constructed within this right-of-way which was named "Harrington Gardens Parkway" by plat.

South of the southern end of "Harrington Gardens Parkway" right-of-way designated as "Rio Grande Boulevard" has been dedicated to the City of Euless. Since the length of "Rio Grande Boulevard" is appreciably greater than "Harrington Gardens Parkway", staff is of the opinion that a single street name should be established and that street name should be "Rio Grande Boulevard".

There are no businesses or properties addressed along "Harrington Gardens Parkway" which would be affected by the street name change. There are only two (2) abutting property owners along "Harrington Gardens Parkway" both of which have been advised of the proposed street name change.

Staff recommends renaming "Harrington Gardens Parkway" to "Rio Grande Boulevard".
