SUBJECT: Consider authorizing the City Manager to execute a TxDOT agreement for the City to assume operation and maintenance of existing non-freeway TxDOT traffic signals.

Consider approval of Resolution No. 11-1373 authorizing the City Manager to execute a TxDOT agreement for the City to assume operation and maintenance of existing non-freeway TxDOT traffic signals.

SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The State, under the provisions of Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, Section 25.5, was authorized to install, operate and maintain traffic signals on State roadways in cities of less than 50,000 population. The State has traffic signals at multiple locations on FM 157, SH 183, SH 10 and SH 360. When a city exceeds 50,000 population (according to the latest Federal Census), the State requires the city to enter into an agreement for the continued existence, use, operation and maintenance of the State traffic signals.

The agreement provided by TxDOT to assume operation and maintenance of existing traffic signals covers only non-freeway intersections on FM 157 and SH 10. The signalized intersections on SH 183 and SH 360 will continue to be operated and maintained by TxDOT.

Resolution No. 11-1373 authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with TxDOT for the operation and maintenance of existing TxDOT traffic signals at non-freeway locations within the City of Euless. Your approval is requested.
