Consider first and final reading of Ordinance No. 1949 amending Chapter 18, "Businesses", Article II, "Itinerant Vendors" and Chapter 30, "Fees", Section 30-23, "Solicitors" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Euless.

**SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:**

The Itinerant Vendor Ordinance will govern solicitation activities, canvassing activities and handbill distribution throughout the city. This ordinance will require solicitors to register with the police department and be clearly identifiable as they go door to door in their activities. The ordinance will allow a resident to place a notice on their premises that will prevent solicitation activities, canvassing activities or handbill distribution at their residence. In addition, this ordinance will place restrictions on the distribution of handbills and the placement of handbills at the residence.
