SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

In 2003, the 78th Texas Legislature passed House Bill 3157 enacting a Municipal Setting Designation (MSD) law. An MSD is an official State designation given to property within a municipality or its extra territorial jurisdiction that certifies that designated groundwater at the property is not used as potable water and is prohibited from future uses as potable water since that water is contaminated.

The purpose of the MSD law is to provide a less expensive and faster alternative to the existing state environmental regulations governing the investigation and cleanup of contaminated groundwater. By providing this alternative way to address contaminated groundwater that will not be used as potable water, property owners may be more inclined to develop or redevelop properties in municipal areas that have contaminated groundwater.

The City of Euless has two (2) groundwater sources used for potable water supply that are located within a five (5) mile radius from the proposed MSD site. The groundwater gradient at the proposed MSD site falls to the east and northeast. The groundwater gradient and the depth of groundwater are such that an MSD at this site will pose no threat to the Euless water supply.

Representatives of the proposed MSD site have approached the City of Euless seeking municipal support for their application to TCEQ for a Municipal Setting Designation. For an MSD to be certified by TCEQ, municipal support is essential. The City of Euless is not obligated to support this or any other MSD application, however, without City of Euless support in the form of the proposed resolution TCEQ is statutorily required to deny the MSD application since it is incomplete.

The City of Grapevine at their May 1, 2012, meeting adopted a resolution of support and by ordinance prohibited the use of groundwater at the proposed MSD site for potable water uses.

Staff has determined that a Municipal Setting Designation for the property located at 1271, 1281, 1293, 1301, 1303, and 1401 William D. Tate Avenue and 800 and 900 West State Highway 114 in the City of Grapevine, Texas, will have no effect upon the quality of water produced from the well located in the City of Euless. Your approval of this resolution is requested.
