Whereas: Roger A. Gatlin attended West Tennessee Business College in Jackson, Tennessee to pursue a degree in Criminal Justice with a minor in Business Administration. In 1975, he was employed by that city as a police officer, and he also worked in Communications for the Tennessee Highway Patrol until 1980; and

WHEREAS, Roger began his career with the City of Euleess as a police officer from September of 1980 to November 1982. After a brief absence, he returned to the City to continue his career in 1984; and

WHEREAS, Roger carried on his education in Criminal Justice at Tarrant County College and earned over 280 education hours as well as completed over 1630 training hours in Criminal Justice. He has received training in Background Investigations, Crisis Intervention, Terrorism and Homeland Security, Narcotics Investigations, Family Violence and Child Abuse, Management and Supervision, and SWAT/Tactical Training; and

WHEREAS, Roger has held the positions of Police Officer, Field Training Officer, Acting Sergeant and Corporal. He is licensed as a Master Peace Officer, Mental Health Officer, School Resource Officer and Basic Instructor; and


