This letter is to serve as an application to request a Temporary Use Permit.

Site description:

- A. The vacant lot on the corner of S. Industrial Blvd and Highway 10. This lot is directly across from the Q-T Gas Station and to the right of the Taco Casa building.
- B. The Parking spaces directly below the vacant lot.

Access: Parking lot is accessible from S. Industrial Blvd.
The owner has given permission to temporarily remove the ropes for the event to allow access.

Parking: Pathfinder parking is on the lower end of the lot (see diagram)
Customer parking is in the parking spaces below the vacant lot. (see diagram)

Sales Items: Sale is a one day event no storage required. Sunday September 30, 2012
Items for sale are housewares, toys, clothing items,
furniture, wall pictures, craft supplies,
All items were donated for this event.

Rest-Rooms: None required for Customer's.
Pathfinders will use Church facilities and/or Q/T Gas Station.

Structures: 8- 6ft tables, 2 - 8ft tables, 7 - 5ft portable shelves for displaying items, patio table with umbrella for Pathfinder seating and shade, 8 lawn chairs for Pathfinder seating.

Security: Pathfinder Club acknowledges that we are responsible for all security.


Permit and Clean up deposit: Attached with this request is a check for \$100.00.
