**WHEREAS:** 229,138 investigations regarding reports of child abuse or neglect were reported in Texas in 2013, with 5,689 of those being confirmed in Tarrant County, and

**WHEREAS,** fourteen child deaths were attributed to abuse or neglect in 2013; and

**WHEREAS,** Alliance for Children provided child-focused services to 2,016 children in 2013, which includes 405 in the Northeast Community; and

**WHEREAS,** Alliance for Children provided prevention education to over 30,000 adults and children in Tarrant County in 2013; and

**WHEREAS,** these prevention programs succeed because of partnerships among agencies, schools, religious organizations, law enforcement, parents and the business community, and

**WHEREAS,** everyone in the community should become more aware of child abuse prevention and consider helping parents raise their children in a safe, nurturing environment.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Mary Lib Saleh, Mayor of the City of Euleess, Texas, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2014 as:

## **CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH**

in the City of Euleess, Texas, and urge all citizens to work together to help reduce child abuse and neglect significantly in the years to come.
