SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The City of Euless currently owns and operates water supply facilities within the City, including three (3) water wells and related facilities, which provide potable water to the residents of the City. Because the maintenance of sanitary conditions around such wells is vital to the protection of the wells and to the protection of the health and safety of the residents of the City, Ordinance No. 2028 establishes the necessary rules and regulations regarding sanitation and pollution control of the areas in proximity to the City's public water supply wells.
