**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Consider approval of Resolution No. 14-1434, calling a runoff election to be held on June 21, 2014, to elect a Mayor to the Euless City Council.

**SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:**

In the event that no candidate for Mayor receives over 50% of the votes on election day, a runoff election will be necessary.

Accordingly and pursuant to Section 2.021 of the Election Code of the State of Texas, and the Euless City Charter, it is provided that if no candidate for a particular office receives the vote necessary to be elected in an election requiring a majority vote, a runoff election for that office is required, and the candidates who receive the highest and second highest number of votes in the general election will appear on the runoff election ballot.

Pursuant to a Joint Election Agreement between the City of Euless and the Tarrant County Elections Administrator, Tarrant County Elections will conduct the runoff election. The runoff election is scheduled for Saturday, June 21, 2014.
