Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract amendment that would extend the interlocal agreement with the City of Fort Worth's Household Hazardous Waste(HHW) program and provide continued participation through FY2015.

SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The most recent HHW interlocal agreement between the City of Euless and the City of Fort Worth allows for three additional one year terms at the same pricing, hours of operation and dates of service. The City of Euless has successfully participated in Fort Worth's Environmental Collection Center (ECC) HHW program since 1997. This service agreement provides for year-round access for current Euless residents to the ECC located at 6400 Bridge Street in Fort Worth. In addition, as scheduling permits, the agreement provides the City of Euless access to the Crud Cruiser mobile collection unit for use in hazardous materials collection events during the year. The \$47.00 fee per participating household rate for FY2015 remains unchanged.
