BACKGROUND:

Notice of the County's intent to bid was advertised in local newspapers, as required by State statute, and posted on the Internet, the Fort Worth Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Metropolitan Black Chamber of Commerce, and the Tarrant County Asian American Chamber of Commerce. Ninety (90) vendors were contacted and requested to participate in this bid process. All documents pertaining to this bid were posted on the Tarrant County website and were downloaded by interested bidders. A pre-bid conference held on August 14, 2014 was attended by six (6) vendors as well as representatives from Transportation Services and Purchasing. Fourteen (14) bids were received.

Bids were evaluated by Transportation Services and Purchasing representatives. Award recommendations are to the low bids meeting specifications. Caldwell Country Chevrolet did not meet specifications for Item 5 because they failed to provide brand/model and delivery time. Cowboy Dodge did not meet specifications for Item 7, 7A, 15, 16, and 17 because vendor failed to provide delivery time. There is no award for Item 11 because it has been discontinued.

Tie bids were received for Item 17. The award recommendation was determined in accordance with Commissioners Court Order #60616, Procedure for Awarding Tie Bids.

The term of the contract is twelve (12) months, effective September 23, 2014 or through the 2015 year model build-out date, whichever occurs first, with two (2) options for renewal periods of twelve (12) months each.

Therefore, it is the joint recommendation of Transportation Services and Purchasing that Bid No. 2014-165, Annual Contract for Purchase of Police Package Vehicles, be awarded to the above listed vendors at the per unit price.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Expenses for last year were approximately \$665,434.00. Orders are placed on an as-needed basis.
