



FIRE/EMS EMERGENCY RESPONSE TIME ANALYSIS JAN-OCT 2014




Response Times






Chapter 42, Article IV

Discussion

Amendment Chapter 42 Health and Sanitation

- Define under Section 42-81:

Electronic vaping device –

“any product that uses a mechanical heating element, battery, or electronic circuit to heat a liquid solution, with or without nicotine, in a vapor cartridge, to simulate the smoking of tobacco product, weeds, or other plant product. An electronic vaping device includes personal vaporizers, electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes), electronic pipes (e-pipes), electronic cigars (e-cigars), and any other type of electronic nicotine or vapor delivery system, or any part thereof”

Update definition of Smoking or to smoke –

“the possession of a burning tobacco, weed or other plant product or the use of an electronic vaping device.”

Amendment Chapter 42 **Health and Sanitation**

Amendments will clarify the City's definitions and regulation for the changing market of tobacco and other forms of nicotine and inhaled substance delivery systems.
