Consider authorizing the purchase of three (3) heart monitors/defibrillators from Physio-Control, Redmond, Washington for Fire/EMS Services.

SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

All ambulances and fire trucks carry life-saving monitor/defibrillators, which are medical devices used to interpret lethal heart rhythms, perform medically specific assessments of a patient and to restore a normal heartbeat by applying a brief electric shock.

This is the final phase of a planned monitor/defibrillator replacement program. This equipment is only available through a sole source due to the specific technical medical application and operations required of the units. This purchase will replace older units in use by the Fire Department
