SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The Americans with Disability Act mandates that the City of Euless provide equal opportunity for individuals with disabilities. Additionally, it prohibits discrimination in access to jobs, public accommodations and government services including programs, services, activities and facilities. The attached ADA Transition Plan is based on a self-assessment and is intended to provide a framework for addressing any barriers that have been identified to providing access to persons with disabilities. The plan includes a grievance procedure, a listing of identified barriers, a summary of actions taken to improve access, a listing of sidewalk and curb ramps that have been completed and those that remain to be completed. The plan is available on the City's website for public review and will be submitted for your consideration on December 9th. It will be updated periodically as items are completed or additional items are identified.
