Whereas: National Work Zone Safety Awareness Week is an annual event aimed at bringing national attention to motorist and work safety and mobility issues in work zones; and

WHEREAS, National Work Zone Safety Awareness Week began in 1999 when the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the American Traffic Safety Services Association (ATSSA), and the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) signed a Memorandum of Agreement pledging to increase public awareness of work zone safety issues through a national media campaign; and

WHEREAS, work zone safety is a primary concern and far too many fatalities and injuries occur in work zones each year; and


WHEREAS, the theme for the year is, "Expect the Unexpected" which was the original theme used in 1999. Since the creation of the national campaign, the number of work zone fatalities has dropped significantly.
