**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Hold Public Hearing and Consider First and Final Reading of Ordinance No. 2069 continuing in effect Ordinance No. 1144, adopted on July 12, 1994, and codified as Section 50-27, entitled "Curfew Hours for Minors" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Euless, Texas; reflecting compliance with all requirements of state law; providing that this ordinance shall be cumulative of all ordinances; providing a severability clause; providing a saving clause; and an effective date.

**SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:**

The City of Euless adopted a Juvenile Curfew in 1994. The Texas law requires such Ordinances to be reviewed and renewed every three (3) years. The Euless Ordinance was reviewed and extended in 1997, 2000, 2003, 2006 and 2009, 2012. The Ordinance will expire automatically on July 12, 2015. Ordinance No. 2069 extends and renews the Juvenile Curfew for an additional three (3) years.
