SUBJECT: Juvenile Curfew Modification

ACTION REQUESTED:

Hold Public Hearing and Consider First and Final Reading of Ordinance No. 2081 modifying and continuing in effect Section 50-27, "Curfew Hours for Minors", of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Euless.

SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The City of Euless adopted a Juvenile Curfew in 1994. The Texas law requires such ordinances to be reviewed and renewed every three (3) years. The Euless ordinance was reviewed and extended in 1997, 2000, 2003, 2006 2009, and 2012. Ordinance No. 2069 was adopted on June 23, 2015. Ordinance No. 2069 extended and renewed the Juvenile Curfew for an additional three (3) years. Ordinance No. 2081 would modify the ordinance by deleting daytime curfew hours for minors between 9:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. on Monday through Friday, while school is in session and related defenses. The remainder of the curfew regulations for minors would continue in effect within the corporate limits of the City of Euless, Texas for another three years.
