ACTION REQUESTED:

Consider a request for a Preliminary Plat of 16.162 acres of the Adam Bradford Survey, Abstract No. 152, Midway Square Addition Block B, Part of Lot 2 located at the southeast corner of Midway Drive and Fuller-Wiser Road to be platted as The Dominion at Bear Creek, Phase 5 Block A, Lots 48R, and 50R, Block R, Lots 1-14 A; B, Block S, Lots 1-19, A; Block T, Lots 1-13; A, Block U, Lots 1-19, A.

1. Approve the request with conditions– *simple majority*

SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

Applicant: Lennar Homes

Location/Zoning: 16.162 acres located at the southeast corner of Midway Drive and Fuller-Wiser Road. The property is currently zoned community business (C-2) district.

Project Description: The applicant proposes to preliminary plat 16.162 acres for the development of sixty-seven (67) single family detached dwelling units and five (5) open space lots. Two of the lots adjacent to Amy Way as it connects this phase of the development to the originally platted areas will need to be replatted. The remainder of the subdivision will be subject to a final plat.

The technical aspects of the subdivision, including setback distances, placement of easements, and street alignment, are in compliance with the regulations of the Planned Development zoning district and the City of Euless Unified Development Code.

Staff is requesting that the Planning and Zoning Commission consider a conditional approval of the Preliminary Plat based on the City Council approval of the Planned Development zoning case 16-01-PD. If upon approval of the zoning case, the preliminary plat will be

effectively approved.

The Development Services Group has reviewed the proposed Preliminary Plat and has certified that it meets the technical standards of the City of Euless. Staff recommends approval.
