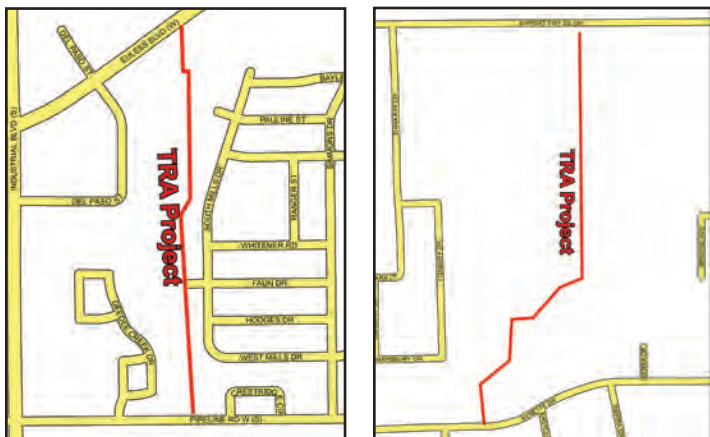

## Wastewater Projects

Beginning in February, the Trinity River Authority (TRA) will begin wastewater line rehab along Boyd Branch, west of Mills Drive between S. Pipeline and SH 10/Euless Blvd. The estimated completion of this project is May 2014.

Also in February, TRA will rebuild wastewater lines along Cyclone Branch west of Wilshire Park between Kynette Drive and SH 183. The estimated project completion is June 2014.

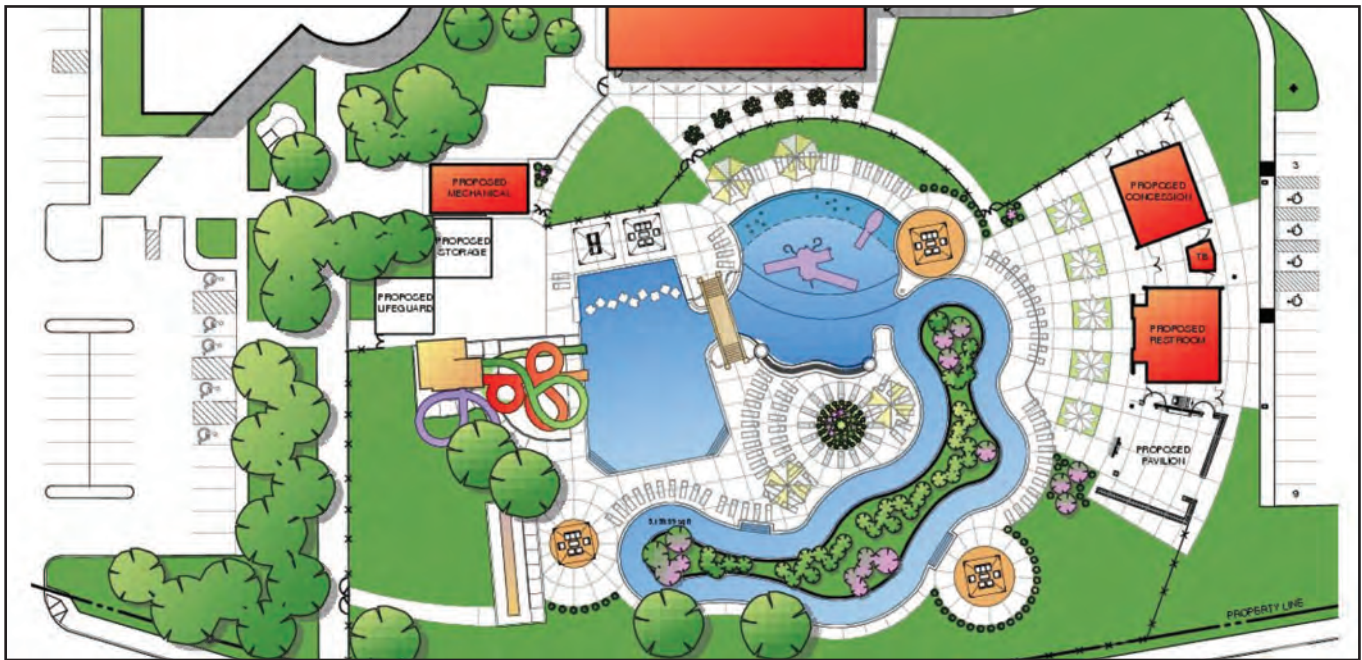
## Join Our Family of Volunteers
