



FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC TEST

Information about the City of Euless Fire Department: The Euless Fire Department has been serving the citizens of Euless since 1956. Today, Euless Fire Department provides Fire and EMS protection to a population of approximately 55,000 people and 16.9 square miles from three fire stations. Euless Fire Department responds to over 4800 calls per year. The Euless Fire Department staffs 1 Engine, 1 Quint, 1 Ladder Truck, 1 rescue squad, and 3 MICU ambulances overseen by the on-duty Battalion Chief.

Salary:

Firefighter/Paramedic - \$5056.00/month. \$60,760 annually

Paramedic Only - \$4877.00/month until Firefighter Certification is obtained.

Firefighter within 3 months of graduating from Paramedic school - \$4877.00/month until Paramedic is obtained.

Requirements for Candidates:

Certified/Certifiable Firefighter/Paramedic

or

Certified Firefighter enrolled in Paramedic school within three months of graduation.

or

Certified Paramedic

Minimum education requirement is High School diploma or GED. Must be at least 19 years of age.

Physical Agility Test:

The City of Euless utilizes Tarrant County College District (TCCD) to conduct Physical Agility Testing (PAT) for Firefighter/Paramedic applicants. **All applicants must have successfully completed the PAT within six (6) months of the date of the written exam.**

A Physical Agility Test will be given at TCCD on Monday, June 19, 2017 for applicants who do not have a current physical agility certificate.
