**WAIVER OF LIABILITY**

I fully understand that due to the nature of the program, there is a chance of physical injury. I agree to assume all risks described and not described herein. I agree to release, absolve, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Eules, its elected officials, fire department, employees and activity officials, any or all in the event of any accident, injury, or death sustained by the above named Participant while being transported to or from an activity, or while participating in any activity, from any liability of any kind whatsoever. I agree to waive any and all claims, including demands, causes of action and suits or liabilities which might arise from such participation, including acts or omissions constituting negligence. I further agree to release or waive any claim that I may have to acquire individually or as a guardian for Participant by reason of the described program. I make these waives and releases to legally bind myself, Participant, my executor, heirs and assigns to the fullest extent now and in the future.

All activities involve some physical nature and I understand and assume all risk. In the event of serious accident or injury, I understand city employees may call 911, provide and perform first aid, and when necessary, recommend transport to a hospital and contact the parent or guardian as soon as possible. I, the parent or legal guardian of the above named participant, do hereby give my approval for participation in the Eules Fire Department Kids Academy and all associated activities. I give permission for any photographs taken during these activities to be utilized for promotional uses by the City now and in the future.

## Eules Fire Department Kids Academy Rules

All camp rules are for your safety and the safety of others. Please follow the guidelines and rules at all times.

1. Please do not bring anyone with you who is not a registered participant.
2. Drop-off time is between 8:30 and 9:00 AM each day.
3. Pick-up time is 3:00 PM **promptly**. (*Employees need to return to work as soon as possible*)
  - a. Each participant is to remain with his/her mentor until a parent/guardian or authorized person arrives.
  - b. Any other pick-up arrangement must be made in advance with the camp coordinator.
4. Participants need to wear tennis shoes every day.
5. T-shirts will be provided Monday. Participants need to wear their Academy t-shirts every day. That is one way we identify our team members.
6. Do not bring valuables to Academy. (*CD players, I-pods, MP3 players, cell phones, money, etc*)
7. Always act appropriately
  - a. Always tell the truth.
  - b. Respect other people.
  - c. Be nice to others, no negative comments or put-downs.
  - d. Keep your hands to yourself. Hitting, kicking, pushing or shoving will not be tolerated.
  - e. Inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
  - f. Rock throwing will not be allowed.
8. Respect other people's property.
  - a. Take care of Academy equipment.
  - b. We will be eating at the tables, please do not sit or stand on them.
9. Each participant will receive a water bottle on Monday. It is the participant's responsibility to keep up with his/her water bottle all week.
10. Participants are to follow the direction of their camp leaders.
