

IMPORTANT NOTICE

The Fire Codes in use in the City of Euless prohibit the use of barbecue equipment in an apartment, on apartment balconies or breezeways or within ten (10) feet of any building, measured from the outside wall or the edge of the eaves, balconies or other projection.

Use of barbecues or similar equipment is ***ILLEGAL*** if used within ten feet of your building or as otherwise outlined in the first paragraph. Violations may subject you to ***FINES OF UP TO \$2,000*** and make you personally liable for any damages or injuries that occur as a result of your violation of this law.

Tragic and costly fires occur each year as a result of barbecue fires that ignite nearby combustibles. Please help us protect you and your property by complying with these provisions.

As apartment residents, also be aware of these code provisions that affect you:

- Never place wood or charcoal ashes in a combustible container until they have had at least 72 hours to cool off adequately. Embers may retain heat for days.
- Motorcycles and other gas-powered equipment are prohibited inside your apartment or in breezeways and similar areas.
- Exit pathways must be kept clear and accessible at all times.
- Parking is prohibited in marked fire lanes.
