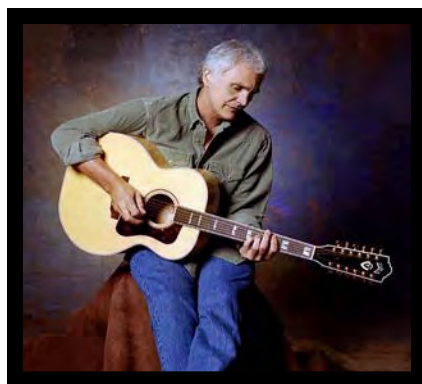


Novel Ideas July 12 & 26 2:00 p.m.

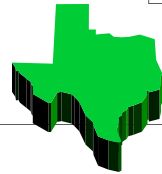


Let's Talk About Books

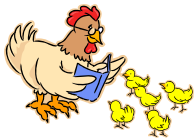
