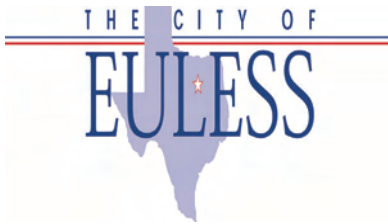

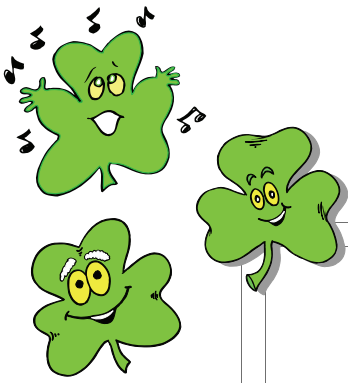
## March Computer Classes
