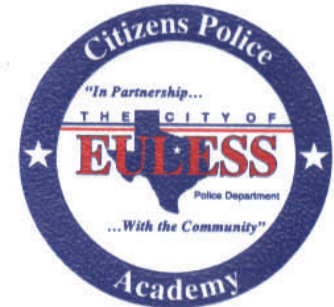

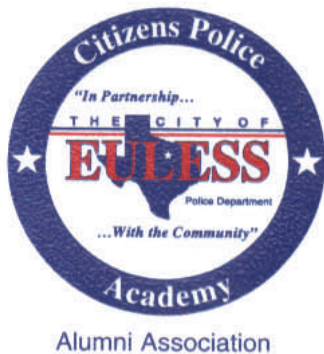

What is the Citizens Police Academy?

The Eulesse Citizens Police Academy presents a look at the internal operations, values, and philosophy of the Eulesse Police Department. The academy is a 36 hour block of instruction designed to give the public a working knowledge of the how's and why's of the department, and the citizens role in their interaction with the Police. It consists of a series of classes, held once a week for three hours. The instruction is comprehensive, covering a different area of Police Department each week. Officers, Supervisors, and personnel assigned to that particular division conduct each instructional block.



The objective

The Eulesse Citizens Police Academy was created to provide enough information to the citizens that attend so they may make informed judgments about the Police Department and Police activities. Students are expected to share this realistic view of the department with other citizens to improve the efficiency of law enforcement in their neighborhoods. The department, in turn, becomes more aware of the feelings and concerns of the community from the participant's interaction and input. It is a two-way learning experience.



Who May Attend?

The class is made up of a cross section of the Eulesse community.

Homemakers, labor, professionals, civic and social leaders, are all encouraged to apply for admission. The minimum age for enrollment is 18 and you must live or work in the City of Eulesse to be eligible to attend.

The Eulesse Police Department hosts two Citizen Police Academies each year, one in the Fall and one in the Spring. Enrollment is limited, due to available space and it is hoped that each student will make every effort to attend each class.

The CPA is a great way to get to know the Police Officers who patrol your neighborhood, and to see your community from their perspective. The CPA will not train you to become a Police Officer, but it will give you valuable insight into the philosophy, strategies, and training that shape your Police Department. This is one of the greatest public education programs that your Police Department can provide. There is no cost to the student to participate, and all instructional materials are provided.
