


**Strengthening Eules CERT — Fire Safety Exercise**

As CERT graduates, we must remain prepared for the day we are called upon to use our training.

During the month of February please re-read Unit Two, Fire Safety. Then spend a few minutes independently thinking through the following CERT Challenge.

Have fun!

It is 9 pm on a Saturday. You are at Softball World watching friends play a Spring League game. Afterward, in the grass parking area, tailgaters with beer and a portable propane grill start a small fire. They yell for help. You dial 911, and then begin the fire size-up learned in CERT training.

Assess your immediate danger. **Personal safety is paramount.**

Ask yourself:

Have I been trained to handle the situation?

Do I have safety equipment and adequate protective gear?

Size-up the situation... Can fire suppression be **safely attempted** by a CERT?

Do I have a buddy to help me? (never attempt fire suppression alone)

Can I escape quickly and safely from this area?

Do I have the correct type of fire extinguisher?

Is the extinguisher large enough for the fire?

Is the area free from other dangers or hazards?

Only if it is safe, take action. Extinguish the fire using the PASS (Pull, Aim, Squeeze, Sweep) fire suppression method.

If it is not safe to attempt to extinguish the fire, leave the situation immediately.
