


### 9-1-1 Day

### Minutes

Geri Sorg talked with the family and told them we would have a brick in Barbara's name placed in the PD courtyard and that a tree would be planted in her honor. Geri attended the viewing, and Mike Brown attended the funeral.

Christmas Provider - Leah suggested that others might wish to shop for the family although she was still willing to work with the agency to get a family needing assistance. At least three volunteers would be needed for shopping. The shoppers will be given sizes and other information as soon as it is available. Shopping has to be completed before the December meeting when we wrap the gifts.

Report of 911 Committee: Betty Overstreet reported that there are 13 dispatchers and one Supervisor. The operation is 24-7. The theme was stars. She and Erelene distributed blue bags tied with a string of stars. Each received utility light, a letter of appreciation on letterhead with the statement you are a Star, Eules Star of the Metroplex, a gift card for \$15.00 to Wal Mart and a handful of Hershey's chocolate kisses. They had a budget of \$250 and spent \$225.11. Thank you Betty and Erelene. You did a great job!

J. R. reported he had acquired a small safe for the ECPAAA office; it was a donation. It will be a way to keep valuable things safe when being left for someone to pick up.

Thank you to all who helped during the hostage situation. Donations were received from WalMart. Food and water were delivered to the officers who were on duty at the site. Many had to remain overnight.

J.R. asked everyone to help promote the ECPAAA as Volunteer Organization of the Year, a program sponsored by the Fort Worth Star Telegram. Everyone was asked to send a letter to the Star Tele-

gram showing their support. Your letters need to be in by Friday, September 22. The letters can be dropped off at the Star Telegram office near West Parkway or sent to Kelley Pledger. J.R. made a sample letter available to the membership, and pointed out that we, as a group, donate over 4000 volunteer hours a year.

Recycle Program - Sonny Sizemore will take over the recycle program at the PD. ECPAAA will get the profits. You may bring your crushed or uncrushed aluminum cans to the PD when you attend the monthly meeting. Containers will be kept out back at the PD. They hope to get a can crusher but for now they will take all the help they can get.

We had several ECPAAA volunteers help at the Bike Rodeo. J.R. will get a copy of a picture taken of all the volunteers for the new sletter and possibly for the website.

J.R. received a call from a David Munson from Florida. Mr. Munson actually spoke with Kay Goad. He wanted us to know that he had viewed many CPA websites and thought we had one of the best in the country. He had requested additional information which Lou and J. R. will provide.

CRUD Day is this Saturday from 9:00 - 11:00 a.m. Volunteers were asked to report at 8:30 a.m. Because someone had to cancel, another male volunteer was requested.

He appreciates all we do. He told us that Christine Clemmer needed 50 volunteers for a Texas Crime Fair/Expo. The event will be held September 29th and 30th at the Will Rogers Exhibity\ Hall. Please call Christine if you would like to help. Information about the Expo was distributed.

Judy Rick asked if we had information on who the new Chief would be. Sgt, Chaney said no, that Bob Freeman was currently Acting Chief.
