Take the Citizens on Patrol program for example. Many people have been trained to ride-out, but we don't have regular participation in the pro-





AUGUST TREASURER REPORT: Motion to approve the August treasurer report made by Geri Sorg, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Helen Voss. After voting, motion passed.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE: Volunteers to serve on the committee were Leah Benoit, Geri Sorg and Julie Watkins.

911 Day: Thank you to Betty Overstreet for her efforts in honoring our 911 dispatchers.

CPAANT: Eules will be host city for the November 1, 2008 CPAANT meeting. Members were asked to bring breakfast items. Volunteers will need to be to the PD by 8:30 a.m. The CPAANT Board will meet from 9am – 10am and the General meeting will be from 10am – 12pm. Expecting 30-50 attendees.

OPEN HOUSE: October 4, 2008. All volunteer slots are full. Volunteer need to report to the PD by 9:30am.

CRUD: October 18, 2008. Jr. advised there are 2 slots he needs to fill.

BBQ FUNDRAISER: Leah Benoit reported on the final figures for the BBQ. There were 143 attendees. Revenue made from Ticket sales were \$1950.00, Auction items \$3643.00, Live meat Auction \$85.00, Afghan sales (3) \$120.00, Door Prize Tickets \$256.00. Net total sales were \$6054.00. Food cost was \$488.00. Total profit of \$5565.00.

EULESS SHELTER: Lou Baum thanked all the CERT members who served at the Shelter. We had total of 250 volunteer hours.

WARRANT ROUNDUP: Lou Baum advised we have opportunity to hold the roundup sessions on a monthly basis. Lou would like to see us hold

sessions 2 nights a week once a month. He feels last Wednesday and Thursday of the month would be best. We would need 10 people per night from 6pm-9pm. This could be a profitable fundraiser earning approx \$720/mo or \$8640/yr.

VOLUNTEER HOURS: Lou Baum advised Volunteer hours up 18%; however we are down 24% on COPS. Sgt. Starnes has offered to ride out and train anyone interested in riding out.

SPEED TRAILER / CANS: John Woodall needs volunteers who can help out with the speed trailer and crushing and processing the aluminum cans. He advised the speed trailer is strenuous work.

Denise asked for comments on Lou's suggestion of holding warrant roundup on monthly basis. General consensus from members is good, will put to vote at next month meeting.

Sgt. Starnes presented documentary depicting the violence of Drug Lords in Mexico.
