

Eulesse Legacy Tree Program Instructions for Nominating a Tree

The Eulesse Historical Preservation Committee, together with Parks and Community Services, is seeking nominations from the public of noteworthy trees for our Heritage Tree Program, initiated in 2017. To be a heritage tree, *one* of the following criteria must be met:

Historic Tree:

A mature tree located at a historic site. If the property owner has old pictures or other information regarding its historical character, this can be extremely helpful.

Some historic trees will be selected to have their DNA (nuts, cuttings, etc.) collected, with permission of the landowner. These will be nurtured by the City of Eulesse in their greenhouse to be ultimately planted in the McCormick Park Famous and Historic Tree Grove.

Champion Tree

A tree of exceptional size, beauty, age, unusual shape, or species that is rare in Eulesse. A tree possessing a large “wow” factor. An example would be the very large Arizona ash on

Arbor Daze Gem


An outstanding, mature tree acquired at a previous Arbor Daze festival which has grown into a “thing of beauty”, enhancing the urban canopy of the City of Eulesse.

Landmark Tree

Any tree which serves as a landmark for the community. An example is the large live oak at the entrance to City Hall.

In addition, the tree must be located within the blue outline on the map below, the greater area once considered “Eules” at one time or another. Note the outline is larger than the City of Eules actual city limits (shaded). Research based on diverse elements such as voting district, school district, and P.O. delivery zone indicates the name “Eules”, for example, was attributed to lands extending as far south as the Trinity River. There are several key historic sites in that area.
