Education, Training & Licenses:

Steve graduated from Raytown High School in Raytown, Missouri. He earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice Administration from Central Missouri State University. His training includes over 3000 hours covering: Tactical Police Driving School; Weapons Training; Firearms Instruction; Terrorism; Armorer, Tactical and SWAT; Command and Incident; and numerous other certifications and training courses. He holds Basic, Intermediate, Advanced, and Master Peace Officer Certification and Police Instructor's Certification.

Employment Background & Experience:

After graduating from college, Steve played Offensive Tackle for the Atlanta Falcons. He then worked in the Security Division at Jones Store (retailer in Missouri) and Montgomery Wards (in Kansas) for approximately two years. He also worked as a patrol officer for the Department of Public Safety in Riverside, Missouri. During his tenure with the Euless PD, he has promoted from Police Officer, to Field Training Officer, to Investigator, to Sergeant, to Lieutenant.
