SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The City of Euless establishes Interlocal Purchasing Agreements with cities when it is advantageous to take advantage of combined quantities or by obtaining pricing offered to a larger entity. Items such as maintenance services, fuel, and street materials are currently purchased through interlocal agreements.

This agreement allows the City of Euless and the City of Greenville to purchase items off each city's contracts as needed. The City of Greenville intends to use the City of Euless pricing for slurry seal.
