Consider First and Final Reading of Ordinance No. 1881 amending Chapter 30, "Fees", Section 30-27, "Recreation Area and Facilities", Section 30-35, "Water & Wastewater Service – Monthly Rates", Section 30-37, "Monitored Group Class", and Chapter 86, "Utilities", Section 86-32, "Delinquency and Service Discontinuance Procedure", of the Code of Ordinances

SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

This ordinance amends the membership fees at the Midway Recreation Center, based on recommended rates provided by the Parks and Community Services department. In addition, this ordinance amends the monthly minimum charge for both water and wastewater, and amends the fees charged for water consumption and wastewater treatment.

In addition, staff is recommending an amendment to Section 86-32, which would discontinue delinquent letter notifications. Customers would still receive a delinquent notification tag at their residents if not paid within 36 days from the billing date.

These fee changes would become effective October 1, 2010.
