SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

On or about January 7, 2011, Oncor Electric Delivery Company filed, with the City of Euless, a Statement of Intent to increase electric transmission and distribution rates by \$353 million in all municipalities exercising original jurisdiction within its service area.

Staff recommends that the City Council suspend the effective date for ninety (90) days to allow more time to study the request. The City participates in the Oncor Steering Committee which will retain legal counsel and consultants to negotiate with Oncor and make recommendations regarding reasonable rates.
