SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The City of Euless is requesting to renew the Joint Grant Agreement with Tarrant County to continue participation in the County's HOME program as a United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) designated metropolitan city.

Tarrant County and the City will cooperate to undertake, or assist in undertaking, program activities to expand the supply of decent, safe, sanitary and affordable housing for low income and very low income Americans.

The County, through this agreement, assumes overall responsibility for ensuring the consortium's HOME program is carried out in compliance with the requirements of the HOME program, including requirements concerning the Consolidated Plan, 24 CFR Part 91.
