SUBJECT: Solid Waste Services Franchise Agreement

Hold Public Hearing and Consider First Reading of Ordinance No. 1970, granting a Franchise to Allied Waste Services of Fort Worth, L.L.C., for solid waste services for the collection of residential and commercial solid waste within the City of Euless.

SUMMARY OF SUBJECT:

The City of Euless, in its desire to provide solid waste services, demands a firm or qualified professional organization that provides efficient and economical residential curbside and commercial container solid waste collection while maintaining maximum sanitary and aesthetic conditions for the community and providing positive communication with the City and the customer.

The City's current Franchise Agreement with Allied Waste Services of Fort Worth, L.L.C. (AWS), is scheduled to expire on February 28, 2013. The City has negotiated with AWS for the renewal of the Franchise Agreement for an additional five (5) year period, beginning March 1, 2013 and ending February 28, 2018.

AWS has agreed to continue to provide solid waste collection and disposal services with an annual fixed rate increase of 3% for the term of the agreement. The monthly contractual rates are set forth in Exhibit A of the franchise agreement.

Staff believes the Franchise Agreement with AWS provides the citizens of Euless with excellent solid waste collection and disposal service at an exceptionally competitive rate.
