After graduation from Sam Houston High School in Arlington, Sherry attended the University of Texas at Arlington where she earned a Bachelor's degree in English. She also attended the University of North Texas where she earned a Master's degree in Library Science.

Employment Background & Experience:

Before coming to the City of Euless, Sherry worked at the University of Texas at Arlington Library, Northwood University in Cedar Hill, and Fort Worth Public Library. She began her career in Euless as 1996 as a Librarian II (Technical Services Librarian), overseeing the cataloging and processing of all library materials. In 1997, she was given additional responsibilities related to the maintenance of PCs and the library network and checkout desk operation, and promoted to Librarian III (Technical Services Supervisor). She became the Assistant Library Administrator in 2004, managing the day-to-day operation of the entire library under the Library Administrator's direction. In 2005-06, Sherry served as Interim Library Administrator until this position was filled. She requested a change to part-time status in 2007 to spend time with her young children and provided front-line customer service at the Reference and Youth desks. Sherry returned to full-time status in 2011 as a Librarian in Youth Services, providing customer service, collection development, and conducting children's programs. In 2012, she advanced to Senior Librarian, Adult Reference Services, overseeing public computer services, collection development, and programs for adults and accepted the position of Library Administrator in 2013.
