#### Drop-in Daycare

Bring your children, 18 months - 7 years old, to the EFLC Drop-in Daycare. Leave them in a safe and fun environment, while you workout guilt free.

#### Recreation Center

Activities abound providing youth, adults and seniors leisurely fun. Those interested in running or walking can use the indoor track upstairs. For those who prefer a little bounce in their workout routine, aerobics classes are offered. In addition, two racquetball courts and a basketball court are available along with a Teen Room with Wii stations, a Sport Wall, two active gaming flight simulators and dance system.

#### Fitness Center

The new 5,000 square foot fitness center features all new cardio equipment including 10 Treadmills, 4 Ellipticals, 2 Stair Steppers, 6 Recumbent Bikes and 2 Upright Bikes. Each piece of cardio equipment has an earphone port so that

you can listen to any of the 5 Flat Screen TV's that are mounted on the wall. The new center also features a new free weight area with all new dumbbells (5 - 75 lbs) and 3 multi-use benches. We also have 16 weight lifting machines to ensure a great workout.

#### Senior Center

The all new 22,000 square foot Senior Center will bring new meaning to the word "fun" for seniors. The Senior Center will have a variety of social and educational activities for those young at heart and mind. The state-of-the-art facility includes a library, media room, computer room, classrooms, game rooms, a medical room and a catering kitchen with adjacent dining areas. Ages 60 and up are welcome to join in the fun activities and special events.

More often than not, a 911 call is NOT an emergency. So, what is a 911 emergency?

1. Any life or death situation.
2. Any injuries or medical conditions where an ambulance may be required.
3. Any crime or suspected crime that is in progress or has just occurred.
4. Traffic accidents with vehicles blocking the roadway.

If you do have an emergency the most important information a caller can give the 911 Dispatcher is your location. Know where you are at all times.

911 Dispatchers are highly trained professionals, and we are here to help. The 911 team at Euless is dedicated to public service. You can help us by taking 911 calls as seriously as we do.



## Feb. 6-12 is Burn Awareness Week

The American Burn Association created Burn Awareness Week as an opportunity to inform the public about the causes of serious burns. Burns are not limited to the effects of just fire, but can be caused by steam, hot food, chemicals and electricity.

Approximately 25,000 people suffer scald burns every year in the U.S. The National Center for Health Statistics reports that 60% of all scald injuries are suffered by young children and most of those burns are scald burns. Please protect you and your loved ones at home. It is recommended that you set the temperature of your hot water heater at or below 120°F. Exposure to water at 155°F can seriously burn a healthy adult in just one second.
