Splash Island is free, family-friendly fun. No matter how hot it is outside, Splash Island provides an entertaining way for people of all ages to keep cool. A magic touch bollard turns on the fun. Interactive spray elements are timed so water only runs when the sprayground is in use. There are several water effects for all children to play in including a raining bucket, an in-ground spray fountain, poles, a colorful misty arch, geysers and a spray column all located on a blue rubber surface. Two benches and a beach hut shade structure provide places for parents to stay dry and supervise while children play. Admission is free.
