Code Compliance

Help us keep Eules an inviting, attractive city by keeping it clean, proactively identifying issues and notifying Code Compliance about potential issues.

Some of the most common violations include:

- High Grass and Weeds
- Trash/Littering
- Outdoor Storage
- Unapproved Parking Surface
- Property Maintenance
- Junk Vehicles
- Illegal Signs
- Fencing in Disrepair

We encourage residents to report code issues by calling 817-685-1509 or using Access Eules online or on your smart phones. Please allow some time for Code to inspect the situation and they will report back to you.

COMMON CODE VIOLATIONS


High Grass and Weeds

Property owners are responsible for maintaining grass and weeds on their property at a height not to exceed 12 inches. They are also responsible for keeping their property free of trash and debris.



Property Maintenance

Property owners are responsible for the general up keep of their property. Fence structures, painting and wood must be maintained in good repair. To ensure safe passage, trees must be trimmed for clearance over sidewalks and roadways.



Signs

May not be placed in the public right-of-way, on power poles, light poles or other public property.



Outdoor Storage

It is illegal to store indoor furniture, appliances, tires, auto-parts and miscellaneous items within public view.


Garbage Containers

May be placed at the curb at 7 p.m. the night before your scheduled pick up and must be returned no later than 7 a.m. the following day after pick up.



Trash/ Littering

Tree limbs and brush must be bundled for curbside pickup. Bundles can be no longer than 4 feet in length and can weigh no more than 50 pounds. To arrange a special pickup for loose brush contact Republic Services at 817-332-7301.



Commercial Vehicles, RVs, and trailers

May not be parked, stored or kept on the street. Temporary permits are available through the Police Department.



Junk Vehicles

Any motor vehicle that has been inoperable for more than 30 days and does not have a current license plate, is wrecked, dismantled, or discarded.

Property owners, agents, occupants and renters have a responsibility to keep their property clean and free of trash and litter.



Trimming Your Trees

Trees in Eules can provide a lot of beauty and shade, but they are also a potential hazard for fire trucks on their way to an emergency. The windshield of a fire truck can easily be shattered due to a large limb hanging low in the street. Fire trucks are taller than they may appear and require a fifteen foot clearance over the street.

You or your neighbors may have recently received a letter from Eules Code Compliance requesting your help with trimming trees on your property. In the event of a fire or medical emergency in your home, or the home of a neighbor, it is vitally important that your neighborhood is rapidly accessible. It is the responsibility of the property owner to maintain the fifteen foot clearance.

If you have trees that may require trimming, please measure the fifteen foot clearance from one foot behind the curb line.
